## **Oil Containment Device Drainage Protocol**

This guidance document provides the protocol to be followed when cleaning out and/or draining fluids from a device used for the containment of oil storage containers.

- 1. Inspect the devices for any signs of oil or an oily sheen.
- 2. If an oily sheen is present contact EHSS. The accumulated debris or fluids (i.e. accumulated precipitation) will need to be collected for proper disposal.
- 3. If no oil or oily sheen is present:
  - A. Remove any accumulated debris from the device.
  - B. Open the release valve on the device and drain out the fluids.
  - C. Reseal the release valve.
- 4. An adequate record of the drainage event must be maintained including the location, date, time, appearance of accumulated debris and/or fluids.
